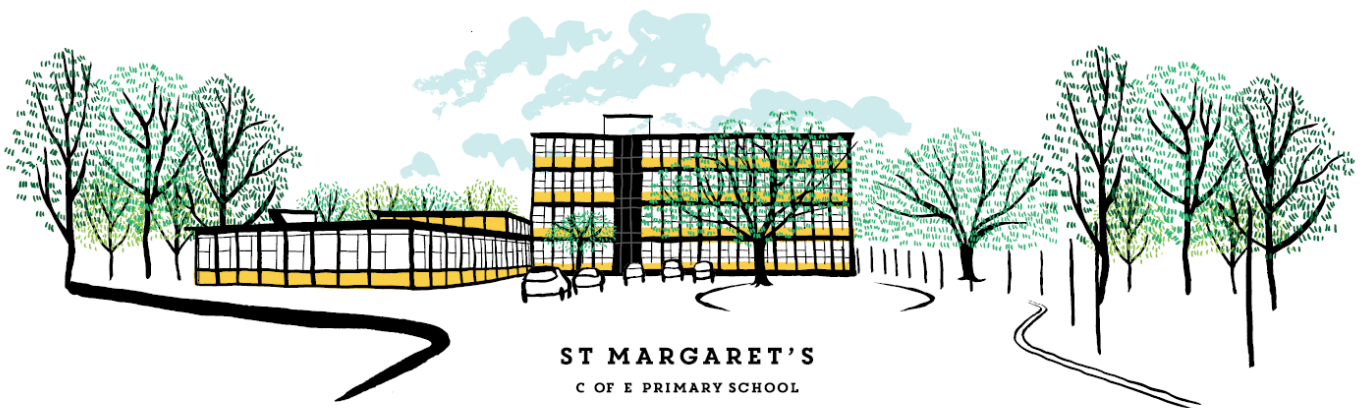

Value of the half term

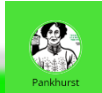
The value of the half term is **Creativity**.

Our value for next half term will be **Curiosity**.

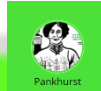
