
During science lessons, Year 3 have been exploring how shadows are made.

Year 2 had a fantastic time completing their art work based on the work of Adam Williamson. They experimented with printing, creating their own stamps for their final piece.




Our nursery children had a wonderful time celebrating Eid with festive parties full of music, dancing, delicious treats, and bright smiles all around!
