Try this at home: Use the rule: "If you wouldn't say it face-to-face, don't send it."



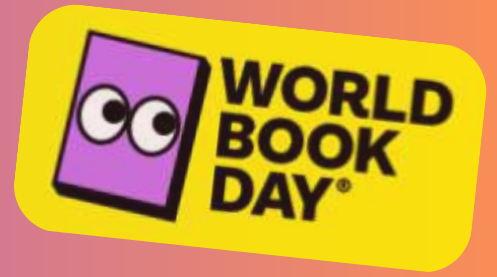
Iftaar
