Reception have begun their new topic - Our Community. We have been talking about our families and learning how to look after our outdoor area

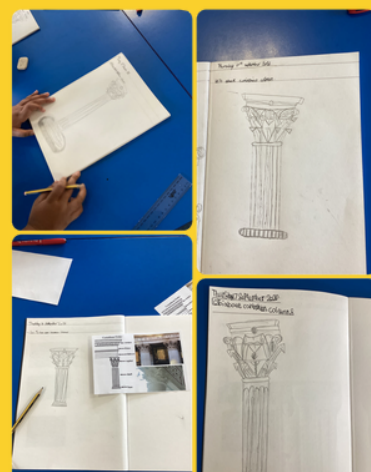


Year 4 have been learning about the different types of Greek columns in their art lessons. This week, they spent time drawing detailed sketches of Corinthian columns.
